### **PETITIONS**

By the following organizations requesting permission to conduct a raffle and have the bond requirement waived: Saukenauk Preservation Society, Inc. from now through 6/12/10; and St. Dominic School Parent Teacher Organization from now through 4/1/11. The City Clerk recommends approval of the permits.

A revocable permit application for encroachment of City right-of-way by Historic Quincy Business District requesting permission to place tables on City sidewalks for the District's Annual Sidewalk Sales between the river and 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Broadway to State, from Thursday, July 15<sup>th</sup> to Saturday, July 17<sup>th</sup>. The City Engineer presents this request subject to four conditions.

### **REPORTS OF QUINCY PLAN COMMISSION**

Recommending approval of the Special Permit to allow a pottery shop and a residential unit to be established on the first floor of the building at 701 Maine.

Recommending approval of a vacation of the right-of-way along the south line of Lot 1 of Knoblock Estates Subdivision subject to maintenance and repair of the detention basin, inlet structure and outlet pipe in the vacated area to be assumed by the property owner of 101 N. 48<sup>th</sup>.

Recommending approval of the Special Permit to allow installation of a 47 space parking lot on the property located at the northwest corner of North 9<sup>th</sup> and Oak, zoned R3, Multi-Family Residential.

Recommending approval of a Special Use Permit for a planned development to allow the sale of firearms and firearms accessories on the internet and directly to the public from the residence at 205 N. 27<sup>th</sup> subject to two conditions.

### **REPORT OF TRAFFIC COMMISSION**

Recommending that a "No Parking" zone be established by painting the curb yellow and proper signage along the south side of Koch's Lane east of the intersection of U.S. Highway 24 and Koch's Lane.
