### **PETITIONS**

By the Quincy Exchange Club requesting permission to hold the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Gus Macker 3 on 3 Basketball Tournament on May 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> in the uptown Quincy area and closing the following streets from 5:00 p.m. Friday, May 27<sup>th</sup> to 9:00 p.m. Sunday, May 29<sup>th</sup>: 5<sup>th</sup>, York to Hampshire; **Jersey, Maine, Hampshire**, 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>. "No Parking" signs will be posted on the above closed streets. They ask the police department be given authority to tow vehicles parked in the restricted areas from 6:00 a.m. May 28<sup>th</sup> throughout the tournament.

By the Franciscan Friars of Holy Cross Friary at Quincy University requesting permission to have their 2<sup>nd</sup> annual city wide Stations of the Cross in the downtown area April 22<sup>nd</sup> starting at 3:00 p.m. They will begin at Washington Park, walking east on the sidewalk on Maine to 8<sup>th</sup> Street, crossing at 8<sup>th</sup> & Maine and walking west on the sidewalk back to Washington Park.

By Quincy Quilt Guild requesting permission to conduct a raffle and have the bond requirement waived from now through 4/17/2011. The City Clerk recommends approval of the permit.
