PETITIONS

By Meals Plus for Seniors requesting permission to conduct a raffle and have the bond requirement waived from now through 6/23/11. The City Clerk recommends approval of the permit.

By The Blind Pig, 900 N. 12th, requesting permission to waive Section **18.039(4)** (Permitting open liquor to leave licensed premises) and **Section 18.030(1)** (Sell outside of licensed premises) **two** outdoor events on Saturday, **July 30th** and on Saturday, **August 27th** with live music, in a fenced in, one entrance area, on their parking lot, with **music from 12:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.** with entire outdoor event ending at 1:00 a.m. with proper permits being obtained.

RESOLUTIONS

City Engineer, Director of Purchasing, and Central Services Committee recommending approval of the low complete bid of Million Construction in the amount of \$29,071 for the repair and replacement of curb, gutter and pavement located at Carol Court with funding coming from 4th Ward Budget.

Interim Director of Central Services, Central Services Committee and Director of Purchasing recommending approval of the low bid of Leffers Landscaping and Nursery, Inc. in the amount of \$10,780 for the purchase of 80 trees for the 2012 Fall Tree Planting Program.

Interim Director of Central Services, Central Services Committee and Director of Purchasing recommending approval of the low bid of Bush Systems, Ontario, Canada in the amount of \$10,384 for 1,600 recycle containers.
