RESOLUTIONS

Airport Director, Aeronautics Committee and the Director of Purchasing recommending the normal bidding requirements be waived and the immediate repairs to a 98 John Deere tractor by Martin & Kroencke, be approved for the amount of \$3,448.18.

Directors of Purchasing and Utilities recommending approval of the low quote of HD Supply Waterworks of Washington, IL in the amount of \$6,465 for (300) 5' curb boxes.

Fire Chief and the Fire Aldermanic Committee recommending the proposal of Physio-Control, Redmond, WA, in the amount of \$27,572.65 for a cardiac monitor/defibrillator life support unit with 90% covered by an Assistance to Firefighters Grant and 10% matching funds from the Quincy Fire Department current operational budget. They will donate the current unit to Blessing EMS.

Fire Chief and Fire Aldermanic Committee recommending the proposal of Towers Fire Apparatus, Freeburg, IL, in the amount of \$37,753.33 for a Gardner Denver/Mako breathing air compressor system with 90% of the purchase covered by an Assistance to Firefighters Grant.

Fire Chief and Fire Aldermanic Committee recommending rejecting the sole proposal from Quincy Industrial Painting Co. in the amount of \$36,000, which exceeds the budgetary figure that was used in planning the repairs covered under the Illinois Terrorism Task Force Training Grant, for repainting the sea/land container training props at the Quincy Regional Training Facility and solicit new proposals.
