RESOLUTIONS

City Engineer, Director of Purchasing and the Central Services Committee recommending the normal bidding requirements be waived and the Engineering Dept. be authorized to purchase four vehicle detection camera systems from the State of Illinois Joint Purchasing Program for the intersection of I-57 & Jefferson St., 3rd & Broadway, 8th & Broadway and 52nd & Broadway for a cost of \$100,400 using Motor Fuel Tax Funds, of which \$62,750 will eventually be reimbursed back to the City of Quincy.

Resolution authorizing the City of Quincy enter into a certain Downstate Public Transportation Operating Assistance Agreement with the State of Illinois in order to obtain grant assistance.

Director of Quincy Transit Lines recommending approval of the proposal from Brasco International, Inc. in the amount of \$33,750 to purchase 10 new bus passenger shelters with funding thru the State/Federal Capital Assistance Grant.

Director of Utilities and Director of Purchasing recommending the normal bidding requirements be waived and the quote of Badger Meter of Milwaukee, W in the amount of \$9,427.09 be approved for a 8” diameter fire line metering device for 4300 Lone Tree Dr.

Fire Aldermanic Committee and Fire Chief recommending approval of the bid from Klingele Construction in the amount of \$9,950 for repair work to the roof at Station #4 which has been budgeted.
