OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

REGULAR MEETING

Quincy, Illinois, March 4, 2013

The regular meeting of the City Council was called to order this day at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor John A. Spring presiding. The following members were physically present:

Ald. Moore moved that the absent Aldermen be excused from this meeting. Motion carried.

The minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council held February 25, 2013, were approved, as printed, on a motion of Ald. Duesterhaus. Motion carried.

The Deputy City Clerk presented and read the following:

PETITIONS

By Quincy Area Autism Support Group requesting permission to walk down Maine Street on April 4th beginning at 6:30 p.m. starting at Quincy Medical Group parking lot proceeding down Maine Street to 5th Street using the sidewalks.

Ald. Holtschlag moved the prayer of the petition be granted and the proper authorities notified. Motion carried.

A revocable permit for encroachment of city right-of-way by the Salvation Army, 405 Vermont, requesting permission to place portable "No Parking" signs and traffic cones in 3 diagonal parking spaces on the north 5th St. side (east side) of the Ray and Joan Kroc Center on various dates. The City Engineer presents this request subject to three conditions.

Ald. Holtschlag moved the prayer of the petition be granted. Motion carried.

A revocable permit for encroachment of city right-of-way by the Quincy Area Convention and Visitors Bureau requesting permission to display various banners across 5th & Maine beginning May 1, 2013 thru December 31, 2013. The City Engineer presents this request subject that the City is not responsible for any weather related damage to the banner.

Ald. Holtschlag moved the prayer of the petition be granted. Motion carried.

By St. Francis Solanus requesting permission to conduct a raffle and have the bond requirement waived from 4/29/13 through 6/8/13. The City Clerk recommends approval of the permit.

REPORT OF TRAFFIC COMMISSION

Recommending converting the intersection of Front and Hampshire Streets from a "2-Way" Stop to a "4-Way" Stop subject to the following condition: Ordinance implementation and signage installation will be dependent on a negotiated appropriate time closer to the actual opening and operation of the business.

Ald. Holtschlag moved the report be received and concurred in and an ordinance drafted. Motion carried.

Second presentation of an ordinance entitled: An Ordinance Granting Variations From Zoning Regulations. (644 Kentucky, reduce number of off street parking spaces for proposed 8 unit multi-family residence from 2 spaces per living unit to one space per living unit)
