### PETITION

- Wards 3,4,7** By St. Jude Run/Quincy requesting permission to hold a run on August 1<sup>st</sup> starting at 6:00 p.m. They are requesting “no parking” signs be set up on July 31<sup>st</sup> on Maine St., 7<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Streets and 21<sup>st</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> Streets, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. to aid in the parking of motor homes via Runner stops and to close Hampshire, 5<sup>th</sup> to Jail Alley, on July 31<sup>st</sup> from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on August 1<sup>st</sup>. The run will begin at 5<sup>th</sup> & Hampshire, go south on 5<sup>th</sup> to Maine, east on Maine to 54<sup>th</sup>, north on 54<sup>th</sup> to Broadway, and continuing out on 104. The Adams County Sheriff’s Department will escort them to the city limits.

### REPORTS OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION

- Ward 4** Recommending that the referral to reduce the speed limit on Kentucky Road from 30 mph to 25 mph be granted.
