**PETITIONS**

**Ward 7** By The Scoreboard, 234 S. 8<sup>th</sup>, requesting permission to waive **Section 111.067** (Permitting open liquor to leave licensed premises) and **Section 111.096** (Consumption outside a licensed premises) on October 29<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. to 1 a.m. in their north and west parking lots for a Halloween party. Closed areas will be fenced off with only one way in and out of the building.
