(Applying for \$245,256 in Economic Development Program (EDP) grant funds and committing \$245,256 MFT funds for reconstruction of York St. from Front to 2nd in support of Kohl Grocer Co. Distribution facilities and \$193,020 in Utility funds for the the York St. water and sewer replacement.)
