Re: Channel Changes to the Comcast Channel Line-up

Dear Mayor Spring:

In Comcast's continuing effort to keep you updated and informed of changes taking place, I wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with information regarding changes to the Comcast channel line-up in your community.

Beginning April 26, 2012, *World Fishing Network (WFN)* will be made available on channel 552 as part of the Sports and Entertainment Package. *WFN* broadcasts fishing-related programming, including both recreational, sport fishing and lifestyle programming. Customers subscribing to the Sports Entertainment Package will be able to view this channel.

Taking place on May 30, 2012, *Spike TV* will be added to the MultiLatino Max package on channel 48. Also taking place on May 30<sup>th</sup>, *Spike TV HD* will be added to the MultiLatino Max package on channel 602. Customers subscribing to Digital Starter or the MultiLatino Max packages will be able to view this channel.

Beginning June 1, 2012, *Mountain West Sports Network (The Mtn)*, currently available on channel 537 will discontinue programming and as a result will no longer be available on the Comcast channel line-up.

Effective July 10, 2012, *CNBC World* will no longer be available on the Comcast channel line-up. *CNBC World* is currently available as part of the Digital Preferred package and is displayed on channel 413.
