The City of Quincy would like all registered vendors for Sealed Bids regarding the Storm-damaged Tree removal & Trimming Project to please include the following information in your bid:

- Please include estimated start date for this project and an estimated finish date that all material will be removed.

The City would also like for all vendors to submit a bid for the removal and disposal of any landscape waste specified in the attached bid specifications. The attached locations are not an all inclusive list, but should provide an adequate listing of most locations throughout the city.

For this project, prevailing wage does not apply.

This bid request will still be due by 11:00 a.m., September 9, 2015 as stated in the original bid packet.

The purpose of this additional bid section is to assist in the removal of storm generated landscape waste in city alley ways and various city right-of-way locations. For the purpose of this agreement landscape waste consists of branches, tree limbs and vegetative material.

PAY ITEMS – Section E

1. GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

- a) All debris removed from alley ways and various right-of-way locations will be disposed of in accordance with Sections 10, 12, 15 and 20 of the Environment Protection Act (title 415 Illinois Compiled Statutes).
- b) Contractors shall be responsible for obtaining any and all permits required for hauling and disposing of landscape wastes and shall pay applicable permit fees.
- c) For the purposes of this contract, all landscape waste which is piled in the immediate close proximity to the alley way or various City right-of-ways, and which is accessible from the roadway with loading equipment (i.e. not behind a fence or other physical obstacle) will be removed.
- d) Entry onto private property for the removal of landscape waste will only be permitted when directed by the Interim Director of Central Services or authorized city representative. All other operations on private property are strictly prohibited.
- e) All contractors will be required to submit detailed load tickets before the City will release any funds. Information that will be required on the load tickets includes location worked, amount of debris picked up, time spent, equipment used, etc.
- f) Debris shall be reasonably compacted into the hauling vehicle. All contractors must adhere to Illinois Department of Transportation standards for hauling.
- g) The City reserves the right to inspect all sites, verify quantities and review operations at any time.
- h) The contractor shall only work during 7:00 am – 7:00 pm unless otherwise directed by the City. No work outside these hours shall be allowed unless approved in advance by the City.
- i) Contractor shall furnish a phone number of a contact who can be reached 24 hours daily.
- j) The City of Quincy reserves the right to select contractors that can meet all of the specifications contained in this document. The selection process will include but not be limited to experience with debris removal, specific expertise needed, and type of equipment contractor has available.

2. CONTRACTED RATE

- a) The contracted rate shall include all of the contractor's costs including but not limited to labor, equipment, repairs, fuel and miscellaneous costs necessary to pick up and transport the disaster debris to the designated site.

3. EQUIPMENT

- a) All trucks and other equipment must be in compliance with all applicable Federal, State, and local rules and regulations. Any truck used to haul debris must be capable of rapidly dumping its load without the assistance of other equipment, be equipped with a tailgate that will effectively contain the debris during transport and permit the truck to be filled to capacity.

Trucks or equipment designated for use under this contract shall not be used for any other work during the working hours of this contract. The contractor shall not solicit work from private citizens or others to be performed in the designated work area during the period of this contract. Under no circumstances will the contractor mix debris hauled for others with debris hauled under this contract.
