PETITIONS

Ward 3 By Prince Agri Products Inc. requesting permission to hold a 5k walk/run to benefit the United Way Of Adams County on Saturday, April 6th beginning at 8:00 a.m. with registration at 7:00 a.m. The route begins behind the Quincy Mall leaving the parking lot at College Ave. exit crossing 36th Street east on Columbus Road to 39th Street then north on 39th to Moorman Park past the lake and around the upper park area returning to the Mall on the same route.
