## PETITIONS

- Ward 7** By the 2015 Quincy Notre Dame Student Council requesting permission to have their Homecoming parade on October 15<sup>th</sup> starting at 7:00 p.m. Line-up will begin at 6:15 p.m. between 9<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Street on Hampshire. The parade will progress down Hampshire to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, south on 5<sup>th</sup> to Maine then east down Main Street back to the starting place. They request assistance of the Auxiliary police.
- Ward 3** By the Quincy Humane Society requesting permission to have a Mutt Strut 5k run/walk on October 3<sup>rd</sup> starting at 10:00 a.m. at Upper Moorman Park. The run/walk will go south on 39<sup>th</sup> Street to Columbus Road, west to 36<sup>th</sup> Street, crossing intersection to the Quincy Mall and back to Upper Moorman Park. They request police assistance with traffic control at 36<sup>th</sup> & Columbus Road.
- Wards 2,3,4,7** By the Great River Road Harley & River HOG Chapter requesting permission to hold the 2015 Salvation Army Toy Run on November 14<sup>th</sup> beginning at 10:00 a.m. This will start at 52<sup>nd</sup> & Oak Street, west to 48<sup>th</sup> St., south to Broadway, west on Broadway to 5<sup>th</sup>, south to Vermont Street, west on Vermont in the Salvation Army parking lot. They request a police escort.
- Ward 4** By the Right To Life Of Adams County requesting permission to hold their annual "Memorial Walk" on January 25, 2016 beginning at 1:30 p.m. starting at the Rock Church, 307 N. 36<sup>th</sup>, walking south on 36<sup>th</sup> to Maine St., circling the bank parking lot and returning to the Rock Church using the sidewalk and parking lot of the bank.
