

**Finance Committee Meeting
City Hall Caucus Room
December 8, 2025**

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Previous Meeting Minutes – The minutes from October 27, 2025 were approved on a motion by Alderman McReynolds. Second by Richie Reis.

Quincy Public Library Tax Levy Request - Mayor Moore discussed the Library levy request stating the Library requested a flat levy of \$1,308,000 plus an additional \$350,000 subsidy for a total request of \$1,658,000. The Mayor mentioned the City Staff could discuss options to save money with the Library. Alderman Reis made a motion to keep the tax levy rate at 0.15 and have the Mayor discuss this with the Library. Second by Alderman Mays. All in favor, motion carried.

Lauterbach and Amen Audit Proposal - Mayor Moore discussed audit challenges and shared our recommendation to use Lauterbach for another 3-year term. Alderman Reis made a motion to recommend resolution to Council on consent agenda with Finance approval. Second by Alderman Entrup. All in favor, motion carried.

Revision to Grocery Tax Ordinance - Mayor Moore stated the City used the “model ordinance” from the Illinois Department of Revenue and they have requested that we make technical change and resubmit. Alderman Reis made a motion to recommend Revised Ordinance to Council. Second by Alderman Entrup. All in favor, motion carried.

Sports Facility Study - Mayor Moore stated Synergy Sports gave a \$5,000 proposal to update the Sports Feasibility study. The original ARCO study was funded by GREDF/Tom Oakley at a cost of \$15,000. The Mayor wanted specifics on the \$5,000 spend since we already have one feasibility study. David Adam stated they have been working with Synergy and Huddle Up for about six months for free. Synergy will update analysis of competing facilities in Midwest, provide a financial model, conceptual plan, and economic plan. The study would be paid for by Economic Growth Fund (food and beverage tax). Alderman Reis made a motion to have Mayor proceed with Synergy \$5,000 proposal. Second by Alderman McReynolds. All in favor, motion carried.

No new business.
