**1. Call to Order**

Chief Yates called the meeting to order at 5:45 PM and attendance was taken.

**2. Approval of Minutes**

**4. Old Business**

**a. Alderwoman Ehman's request for a streetlight at 935 Country Club Drive West**

Ameren estimated the cost to install the light would be in excess of \$7,500 due to the location not being near an electrical service line.

**Motion:** *To recommend approval of the installation of the streetlight at 935 Country Club Drive West subject to the 4<sup>th</sup> Ward alderpersons direction and allocation of 4<sup>th</sup> Ward funds to the installation.*

### b. Speeding on South 43rd Street and Covington Lane

The speed study data acquired on S. 43<sup>rd</sup> Street & Covington Lane was discussed. A lengthy discussion followed touching on children's safety, traffic calming measures and lack of a set policy. The largest 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed was 6 mph over the 25-mph speed limit. This data was acquired when South 48<sup>th</sup> Street was closed at State Street, therefore increasing the amount of traffic on both streets. Once 48<sup>th</sup> Street reopens, the traffic volumes are expected to decrease.

**Motion:** *To deny any further action on South 43<sup>rd</sup> & Covington Lane.*

### c. Alderman Bauer's referral to study parking on College between 11th and 12th Streets

Alderman Bauer stated that after the curbs at the intersection were repainted, the residents stated the problem continued. Chief Yates stated that they would increase enforcement of the no parking area there.

**Motion:** *To have Central Services install "No Parking" sign(s) on the north side of College west of 12<sup>th</sup> Street in the area with a yellow curb.*

## 5. New Business

### a. Fire Department's request for a fire lane on 2nd Street, Broadway to Spring Streets

A new residential development is planned near 2<sup>nd</sup> & Broadway. The only access to the apartments will be a single driveway off the west side of North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street making it difficult for emergency vehicles to turn into the development.

**Motion:** *Recommend the City Council designate the 200 feet of the west and east side of North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street centered on the proposed drive as a "fire lane" (70 feet south of the*

*centerline of Spring Street to 270 feet south of the centerline of Spring Street).*
