Special Event Application from the Quincy Area Chamber of Commerce requesting permission to hold the annual Dogwood Parade on Saturday, May 3, 2025. The parade will begin at 9:30 a.m. at 24<sup>th</sup> & Maine St. and will disband on 6<sup>th</sup> Street between Jersey and Hampshire Streets. Parade entries will line up on Maine St. between 24<sup>th</sup> and 36<sup>th</sup> Streets beginning at 7:00 a.m. that morning. There will be a delayed start in the event of rain. Closure of Maine St., 5<sup>th</sup> to 36<sup>th</sup> Streets and 6<sup>th</sup> St., Jersey to Hampshire Streets from 7:00 a.m. through 1:00 p.m. with barricades are requested. "No Parking" signs are requested along the parade route by 12:00 (noon) on Friday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Auxiliary Police Officers are requested at major intersections along Maine Street. Organizers will be responsible for the street clean-up following the event. The applicant has submitted all required documentation, and approval is recommended by the Department of Utilities & Engineering.
