Chief of Police recommending approval to pay the yearly support and maintenance fee in the amount of \$35,803.33 to Caliber Public Safety, DBA InterAct Public Safety Systems, Chicago IL for computer software for the Mobile Data System that provides instantaneous communication with officers and the 9-1-1 Emergency Dispatch Center.
