Utilities Committee Meeting Minutes

June 4, 2026

The monthly meeting of the Utilities Committee was held at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 4, 2026, at Quincy City Hall. Members present were Alderman Dave Bauer, Alderman, Greg Fletcher, and Alderman Richie Reis. Director of Public Works Jeffrey Conte, Corporation Counsel Bruce Alford, Alderman Glen Ebbing, and Theresa Alford were also present.

Approval of Minutes

Operating Report

Conte presented the operating report for the water treatment and water distribution systems for the month of May.

Sewer Fund

Waste Water Treatment Plant Report

Jeffrey Conte presented the monthly report to the Committee.

WWTP Solar RFP Review

The City has received a grant in the amount of \$1.4 million for the installation of a solar PV system on City-owned property to reduce operating expenses. The grant includes a \$1.6 million match by the City, for a project total of \$3 million. The City requested proposals for the design, installation, operation and maintenance of the system. Eight (8) proposals were received. The proposals were reviewed and three (3) firms were selected for interviews. Two (2) finalists were then selected, and the proposals were brought to Committee for vendor selection. The proposal from Vergy of St. Louis offers a 525kW system at the Waste Water Treatment Plant (\$2,686,232) and a 600kW system (\$2,841,841) at the Chestnut Street Reservoir.

Action: The Committee selected Vergy as the vendor for the project and authorized staff to finalize the contract for a 525kW solar PV system at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.

Motion: Fletcher/Reis Motion Carried
