#### **a. Alderman Bauer's request to review parking near 2014 Chestnut/QU parking on Chestnut Street east of 20th.**

Chief Yates stated that the QPD had discussed the matter with both the residents and QU. The issues between them cannot be addressed by the Traffic Commission.

#### **b. Alderman Atkin's request to install a streetlight in the 400 block of Locust Street**

It was determined that there was adequate lighting along this section of Locust Street and that it was likely to have been Maple Street.

**Motion:** *To deny the request for an additional streetlight in the 400 block of Locust.*

### **5. New Business**

#### **a. Alderman Bauer's referral to install a streetlight at 1500 Oak Street.**

Alderman Bauer explained that the block of Oak Street from N. 15<sup>th</sup> to N. 16<sup>th</sup> is dark due to a lack of a mid-block streetlight and numerous trees. Also, the block of Oak from 17<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> also does not have a mid-block light. There are no power poles in the parkway for Ameren to attach a light to on these 2 blocks.

**Motion:** *Table 1 month to allow the Engineering Department to get a price from Ameren to install a new mid-block streetlight between 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>, and if the cost is less than \$7000 the referral will be sent to City Council without further review by the Traffic Commission.*

### **b. Alderman Fletcher's referral to install a streetlight on Maple Street, 4th to 5th.**

Alderman Fletcher requested a streetlight between 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> on Maple on existing the power pole.

**Motion:** *Recommend the City Council approve the request for a streetlight on Maple Street between North 4<sup>th</sup> and North 5<sup>th</sup>.*

### **c. Alderwoman Mays' referral to install a streetlight at Glenayre Way & Hollister Whitney Parkway.**

### **e. Alderman Uzelac's referral for a mid-block crossing on Vermont Street, 4-5th (Kroc Center).**

The Kroc Center reached out to the Engineering & Planning Department about adding a crosswalk across Vermont since so many people in the parking lots on the south side of Vermont cross there to go into the building. A discussion was held about how mid-block crosswalks have been denied in the past due to safety concerns and that a proper mid-block crosswalk would require a bump-out and removal of parking on Vermont.

**Motion:** *Recommend the City Council deny the request for a mid-block crosswalk on Vermont Street between North 4<sup>th</sup> and North 5<sup>th</sup>.*
