1. Call to Order

With Chief Yates absent, Ed Holthaus called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and attendance was taken.

2. Approval of November 10th, 2025, Minutes

3. Public Comment (3-minute limit)

Dan Lenan spoke about the need for additional traffic control at the intersection of 21st & Van Buren. He stated that his wife was in an accident there and that it is very difficult for northbound vehicles to see oncoming traffic from the east due to the embankment.

4. Old Business

a. Alderman Bauer's referral to install a streetlight at 1500 Oak Street.

Central services will be removing a tree on the north side of Oak on the east half of the block between 15th & 16th. Once the tree is down, Ameren will have an easier way to install the streetlight from the east.

b. Alderwoman Mays' referral to install a streetlight at Glenayre Way & Hollister Whitney Parkway.

Engineering confirmed that the light poles were Ameren's. Ameren looked at the intersection and notes that one of the lights was out. They were not in favor of adding a 3rd light to the intersection.

Alderwoman Mays inquired about adding a flashing LED pedestrian sign to bring attention to the crosswalk. It was determined that either the 3rd Ward or Holister-Whitney could cover the cost of installing the LED flashing signs.

Motion: *To deny the request for an additional streetlight at Glenayre Way & Hollister Whitney Parkway.*

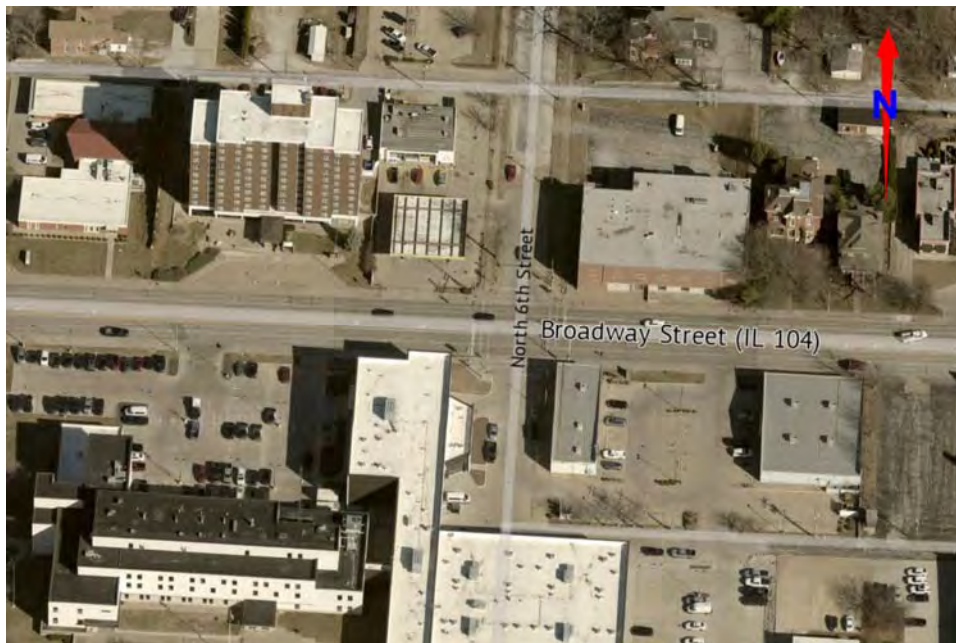

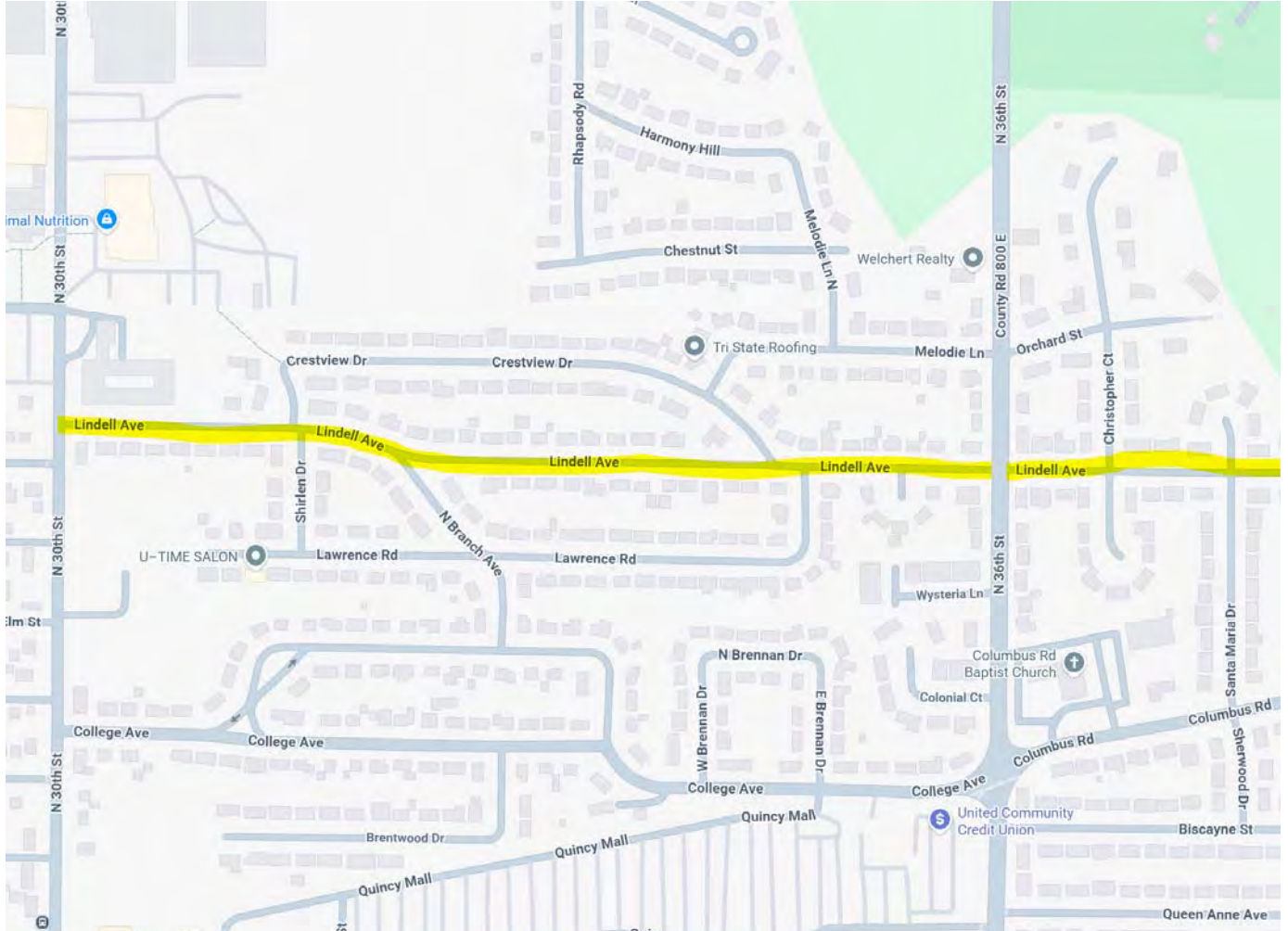
City Council approved, Ameren installed the light for approximately \$1700.

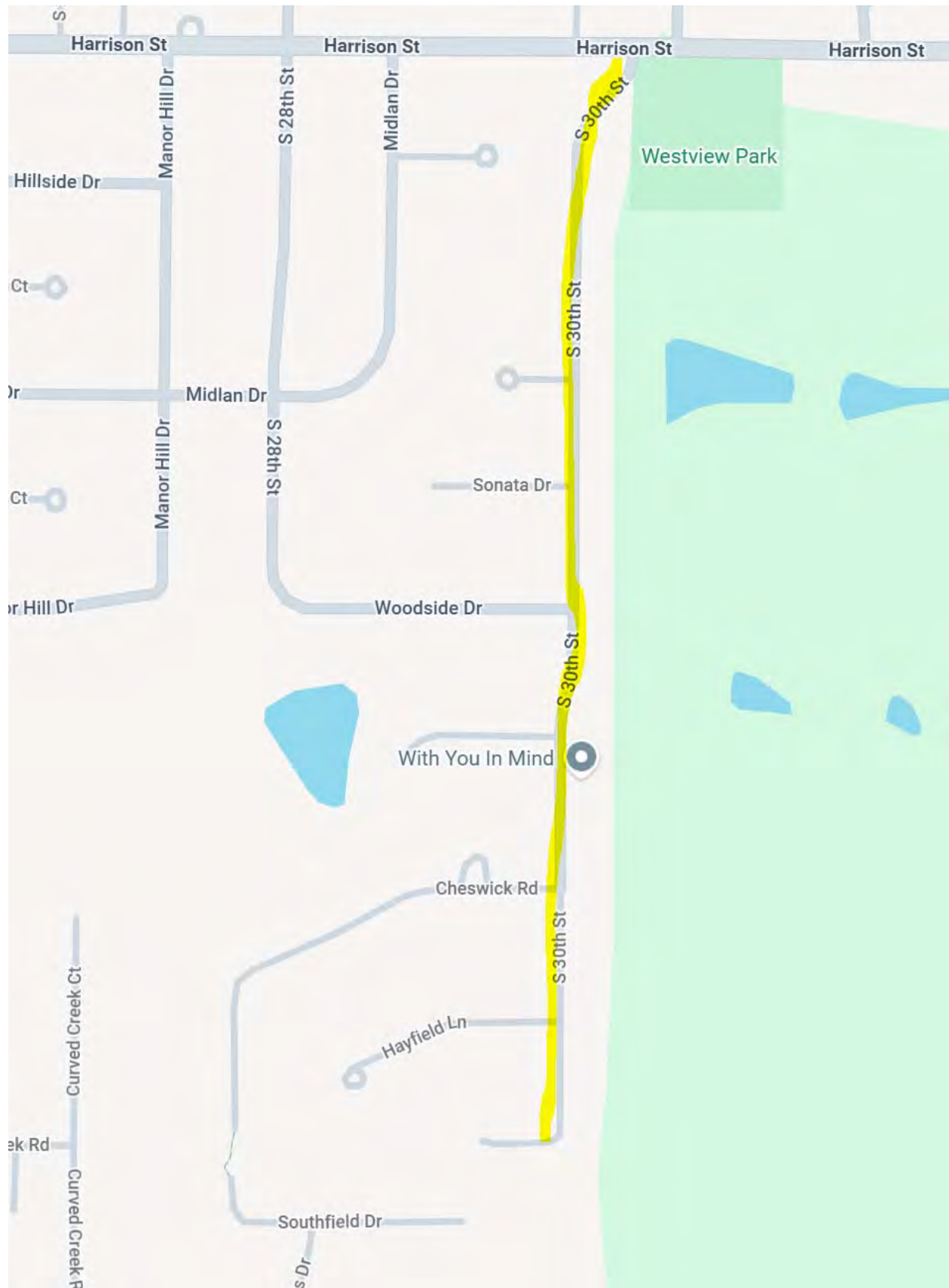
East bound Traffic on Lindall 30th-36th

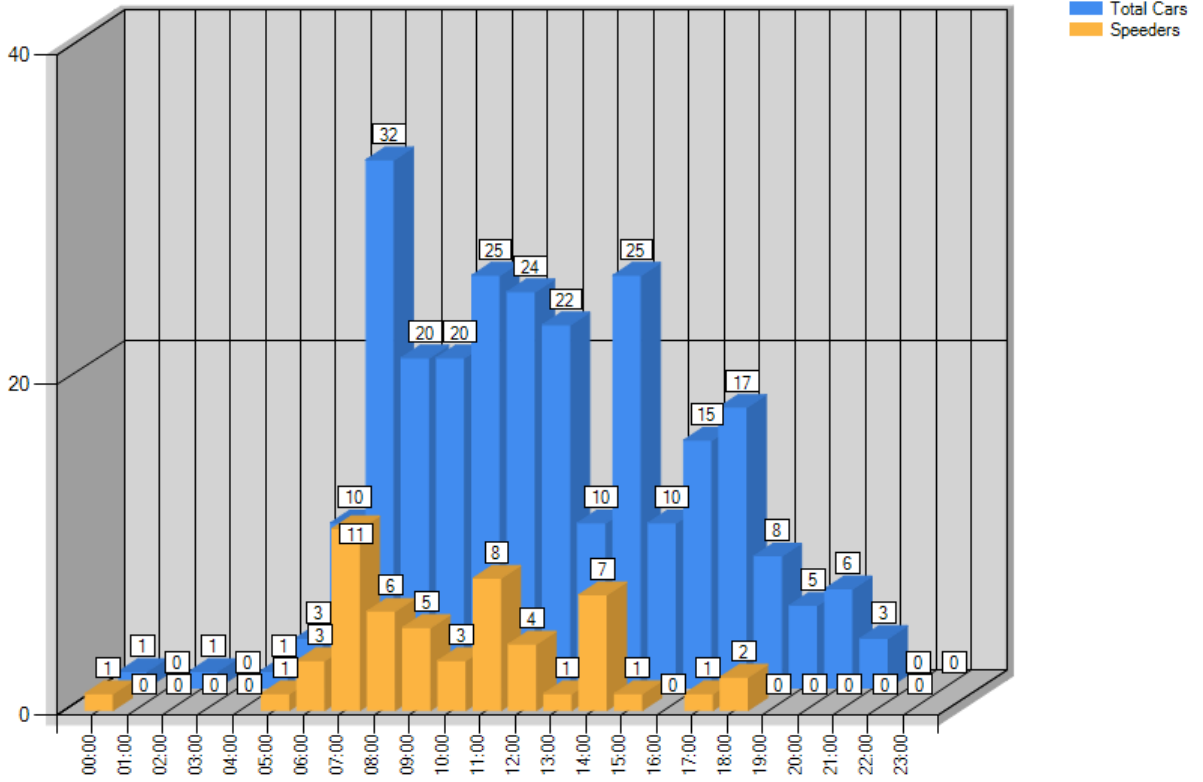

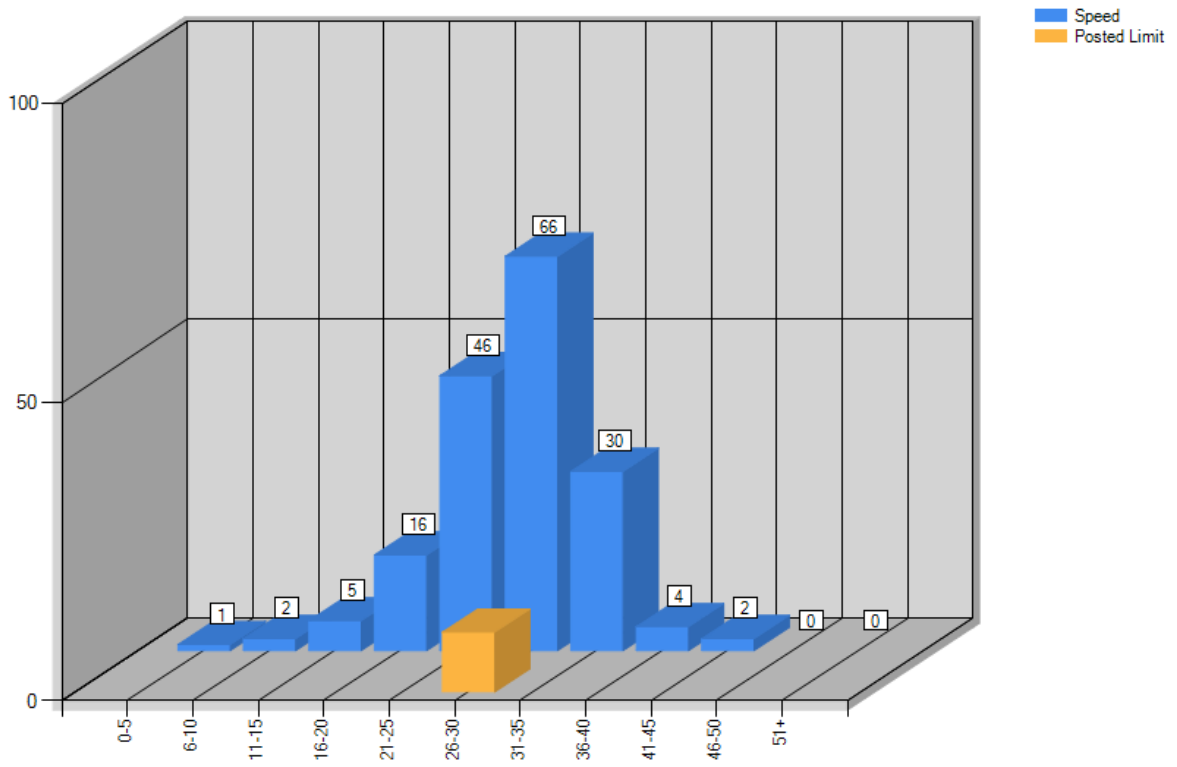
