#### 4. Old Business

- a. **Ald. Mays request to reduce the speed limit on Nottingham Drive. (Tabled 1 month at the May 2026 & June 2026 meetings.)**

Justin Boyd stated the results of the speed study showed a top speed of 22 mph and the 85<sup>th</sup> % speed of 21 mph.

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- b. **Ald. Bergman request for the Traffic Committee for caution children playing signs at the alley entrances at 20th and 22nd between Cedar and Cherry. (Tabled 1 month at the June 2026 meeting to allow the resident to attend).**

The resident requesting the signs was not in attendance. It was noted that the Traffic Commission Guidelines do not recommend installing "Children Playing" signs.

- c. **Ald. Bergman request for the Traffic Committee for additional streetlight at Cedar St between 20th and 22nd (Tabled 1 month at the June 2026 meeting).**

Alderman Bergman stated he had looked at similar blocks in the neighborhood and have 4 lights on a block like there currently are on Cedar between 20<sup>th</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> was common.

### **5. New Business**

- a. **Engineering Department's request to revise Chapters 10.99 and 74.99 of the City Code to have a consistent fee of \$250 in line with IL statute.**

It was explained that a few years ago all traffic violation fees were doubled in the City Code. That included increasing the fee for illegally parking in a handicapped stall to \$500 from \$250. Since IL law does not allow municipalities to increase this fee over \$350, the \$500 fee is not enforceable.

**Motion:** *To recommend the City Council amend Chapter 10.99 of the City Code to reduce the fee for parking in a handicapped space to \$250.*
