It is with great pleasure that I announce Officers Taylor Dralle, Andrew Cox, Kelby Rescinito, and Kyle Holtmeyer have been selected as Employees of the Month for December 2019.


Officer Dralle began her career on December 28, 2015, Officer Cox on June 14, 2016, Officer Rescinito on January 3, 2017, and Officer Holtmeyer on June 19, 2017. These officers all work Patrol on the night shift.

The officers were nominated for this recognition due to their collective work at the scene of a violent disturbance that resulted in life threatening injuries on September 29, 2019. Their quick actions saved at least one life.

At approximately 10:52 p.m. that date, officers were dispatched to a residence where there had been a fight and one subject was stabbed. Upon arrival, Officer Dralle identified the suspect and immediately took him into custody. Meanwhile, Officers Cox and Rescinito arrived on scene and located the victim, who was unconscious and bleeding profusely from a stab wound to the left leg and a large wound to the left arm. Officer Cox immediately requested a tourniquet. Officer Holtmeyer, who was arriving on scene, responded with the first aid bag from his squad car; he also offered up the use of his personally owned tourniquet. Officer Cox prepared the tourniquet while Officer Holtmeyer donned on his personal protective equipment. Officer Holtmeyer then applied the tourniquet. The victim was transported to Blessing where he was stabilized and taken into surgery and survived. Detectives also responded and ultimately took over the crime scene. The suspect was lodged in jail on a charge of Aggravated Domestic Battery.

The quick response and actions of all of the officers that night saved lives. Officer Dralle prevented potential harm to others by quickly controlling and arresting the suspect. Officers Cox, Rescinito, and Holtmeyer provided emergency first aid that more than likely saved the life of the victim.

Please join me in congratulating each of these officers for being selected as the Quincy Police Department Employees of the Month.
