Dear Police Aldermanic Committee:

The purpose of this letter is to make you aware of a grant opportunity for our department and to request support in requesting authorization from the City Council to submit an application. We must share this grant with the Adams County Sheriff's Department; we will act as the lead agency throughout this process.

The Justice Assistance Grant program requires the applicants to notify their governing body of the application availability and to receive approval to submit an application. In addition to the governing body notification and approval, we are also required to make a notification to the public to allow them the opportunity to comment on the intended use of the funds. The necessary information is posted on the City's website.

The Quincy Police Department will be moving to a new police department, sharing a facility with the Adams County Sheriff's Department. If awarded the funds, the Quincy Police Department would spend our portion of the money on new office furniture and storage systems for this facility.

We request authorization to proceed with this application. We will be taking this request to the full council on Monday August 07, 2017.
