
To Whom It May Concern,

It is with great pleasure that I announce Officer Zach Bemis and Officer Zach Tuley have been selected as Employees of the Month for February 2019.

Officer Bemis joined the Quincy Police Department on September 14, 2015. He graduated from Police Basic Training on February 17, 2015. Officer Bemis is a breath alcohol operator, a Crisis Intervention Team officer, a Designated Marksman, and a member of the Emergency Response Team. Officer Tuley joined the department on January 3, 2017. He graduated from Police Basic Training at Moberly (MO) Area Community College Law Enforcement Training Center; he previously served on the Hannibal (MO) and Galesburg police departments. Officer Tuley also is a breath alcohol operator, a Crisis Intervention Team officer, a Designated Marksman, and a member of the Emergency Response Team. Both officers are currently assigned to the Street Crimes Unit.

Officers Bemis and Tuley were nominated due to their work on an investigation into numerous business burglaries and thefts that occurred in the Quincy area. They found that the crimes were connected and they developed information on a male subject who was involved in the crimes. After working the case for several weeks, gathering intelligence and conducting surveillance, they located and arrested the subject and his accomplice. The accomplice was arrested for a felony warrant and a new charge of Burglary. The original subject was arrested for a felony warrant and two new counts of Burglary, two counts of Theft, and Possession of Methamphetamine.

Officers Bemis and Tuley worked hard and showed resolve and commitment to apprehend these subjects and put a stop to their string of criminal activity. This type of dedication to the job and our community makes the officers more than deserving of this recognition.
